W. Anthony Riley, MD - Winner of the Lifetime Achievement Award

As a leading expert in the field of geriatrics, hospice and palliative care, Dr. Riley has dedicated his professional life to caring for the elderly, those suffering from serious illness and those at the end of life. His contributions have resulted in more comprehensive and coordinated high-quality care for more seniors with serious illness, particularly for underserved populations. Under his medical leadership, Gilchrist and GBMC have provided a seamless continuum of care that allows physicians to follow elderly patients throughout the medical system, from the hospital and medical offices to home-based care and eventually palliative and hospice care.

Dr. Riley has helped create programs and services at Gilchrist that have grown the geriatrics, palliative medicine and hospice programs into one of the region's most esteemed services. He has developed many innovative programs to help close the gap in care for populations whose needs were previously unmet. Many patients have expressed their gratitude for Beverly's care and note that she truly goes above and beyond her job responsibilities, such as collecting and delivering food to needy patients.
