## Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall in Maryland

The Traveling Memorial Wall is a 3/5 scale of the Vietnam Memorial in Washington DC; it stands six feet tall at the center and covers almost 300 feet from end to end.

This Traveling Memorial stands as a reminder of the great sacrifices made during the Vietnam War. It was made for the purpose of helping heal and rekindle friendships and to allow people the opportunity to visit loved ones in their hometown who otherwise may not be able to make the trip to Washington.

The Traveling Wall will be in New Windsor, Maryland October 9-13, 2025. Below is the information you will need to plan your visit to see this memorial and to hear nationally known speakers who served in Vietnam. Plan to come early to visit the numerous veteran related displays and service organizations.
